

Calhoun County Consolidated Dispatch Center Authority Governing Board

Meeting Minutes Tuesday, September 8, 2009

The Meeting was called to order by Chairman Peterson at 3:05 p.m., in the Law Library of the Marshall County Building. It was noted that there is not a quorum of board members present, so reports will be read, but no formal action will be taken.

II. Executive Director Report

Mr. Troyer updated the Board on a number of meetings held between himself and the City of Battle Creek and Calhoun County. Battle Creek's existing contract with Motorola will be reassigned to the CCCDA but the debt will remain the responsibility of the City of Battle Creek, with the CCCDA paying the debt costs directly to Battle Creek. Agreements are being prepared to finalize Battle Creek's \$250,000 contribution to the center's construction, as well as Battle Creek's offer to finance up to \$1 Million in additional capital costs over a term of five years with an interest rate equal to 5.00%. Mr. Troyer expects the CCCDA to borrow between \$500,000 and \$700,000. Chairman Peterson recommended that the borrowed funds be repaid as soon as possible, and before the five year term, if able. Mr. Troyer will have a draft budget for Board approval at the next regular meeting.

Mr. Troyer is still having a difficult time connecting with the labor attorney. Mr. Tsuchiyama will attempt to call him as well. Chairman Peterson recommended that the Board considers other options for this position after the initial organizational work is complete.

Mr. Troyer and Mr. Lindsay are working on an agreement for internal administrative services, which Calhoun County has offered to provide.
