EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Executive Director Feole reported on the following items:

- 1. Hiring Process: we are in the final steps of the hiring process. All of the positions have been offered and all have accepted. We hired four full time employees and one part time. There were lots of good candidates with this round.
- 2. Purchased Software: Agency360. We looked into four companies total and decided on this one. It is being used by other area agencies. It will make tracking trainings smoother and more efficient and well as more accessible.
- **3.** Center Squared- Webinar: CAD will still be supported, updates will still be released. It will just not be continued to be actively sold. There is no "end of life" date which is known. Jim Blocker asked what current programs will interface with CentralSquare, I.E. RMS. Steve Frisbie asked cost to replace? Is there a plan in place for future replacement? He asked that Director Feole get a financial plan in place to be prepared to replace the CAD system when the time comes.

Erin Allwardt Trainer: Erin has completed her training and certification to become a trainer for the 40 hour basic telecommunicator class, which is a state mandated class for all emergency telelcommunicators. We will now be able to cover the class in house instead of having to reimburse for mileage, meals, hotels, class registration.
